THE DAY OF RESURRECTION

What is the Doomsday?

Doomsday is the time when the angel Israfil is commanded to destroy all creatures in this world and in the spiritual realm. It's not just the Earth that will be destroyed; all stars and celestial objects will also be annihilated. Even the entire universe will be destroyed.

The same applies to all creatures in the spiritual realm, including jinn and all the angels, including the Angel Jibril. The last angel to die will be the angel Israfil himself.

Only a few creatures are exempted from this destruction by Allah s.w.t. These creatures continue to exist after Doomsday. They include Paradise, Hell, the spirits of human beings, Allah's Throne (Arash), and the Bone of the Tailbone (Ajb Dzanb).

The Ajb Dzanb is located at the very end of the spine. It is an extremely small bone. Even if a corpse is burned or eaten by another creature, Allah s.w.t will not destroy this small bone.

What is the Day of Resurrection?

Day of Resurrection is the moment in which humans will be made alive again after Doomsday's destruction. After a certain period, once everything has been destroyed, Allah s.w.t creates a planet similar to Earth with a sky similar to that of the Earth now. All the Ajb Dzanb bones are then placed on the surface of this planet.

Afterward, Allah s.w.t sends down rain. The Ajb Dzanb suddenly enlarges and forms the spinal column. From there, all other bones begin to grow, forming the entire skeleton. Then Allah s.w.t creates the flesh, nerves, skin, and all human organs.

Once everything is complete, Allah s.w.t places the spirit of each person into their body. At that moment, the life is restored, and they stand up.

What will happen after humans are resurrected?

Now, as they stand there naked, it becomes their new reality.

What does the Al-Hisab mean?
